

## Autumn 2017

Pupils will be working on these objectives:

Demonstrates friendly behaviour, initiating conversations & forming good relationships with peers & familiar adults

- Is more outgoing towards unfamiliar people and more confident in new social situations.
- Confident to talk to other children when playing, & will communicate freely about own home and community.
- Aware of the boundaries set, & of behavioural expectations in the setting.
- Listens to others one to one or in small groups, when conversation interests them.
- Listens to stories with increasing attention and recall.
- Maintains attention, concentrates and sits quietly during appropriate activity
- Listens and responds to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion.
- Uses language to imagine & recreate roles & experiences in play situations.
- Handles tools, objects, construction & malleable materials safely & with increasing control
- Experiments with different ways of moving.
- Jumps off an object and lands appropriately.
- Can write their first and where appropriate their surname.
- Recognises familiar words - own name and simple key words
- Continues a rhyming string
- Counts reliably upto 10 objects and begins to recognise and understand the numbers 0-5 and then 6-10
- Can name 2D and 3D shapes
- Remembers and talks about significant experiences in their own lives and that of those close to them.
- Knows some of the things that make them unique, & can talk about some of the similarities & differences in relation to friends or family.
- Recognises similarities and differences
- Create simple representations of events, people and objects.
- Initiates new combinations of movement and gesture in order to express & respond to feelings
