

## Summer 2018

Pupils will be working on these objectives:

- They are confident to speak in a familiar group, will talk about their ideas, & will choose the resources they need for their chosen activities. Children talk about how they & others show feelings, talk about their own & others' behaviour, & its consequences, & know that some behaviour is unacceptable.
- They listen to stories, accurately anticipating key events & respond to what they hear with relevant comments, questions or actions.
- Children follow instructions involving several ideas or actions.
- They answer 'how' and 'why' questions about their experiences and in response to stories or events.
- Children express themselves effectively, showing awareness of listeners' needs.
- They develop their own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events.
- Children show good control and co-ordination in large and small movements. Including using pencils effectively when writing and forming letters.
- Children know the importance for good health of physical exercise, & a healthy diet, & talk about ways to keep healthy & safe.
- Children read and understand simple sentences. They use phonic knowledge to decode regular words and read some irregular words on sight.
- Demonstrate an understanding of books when talking to others about what they have read.
- Begins to read words and simple sentences.
- Children use their phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds. They also write some irregular common words correctly.
- They write simple sentences which can be read by themselves and others.
- Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order
- Using quantities & objects, they add & subtract two single-digit numbers & count on or back to find the answer
- They explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes & use mathematical language to describe them.
- Children talk about past & present events in their own lives & in the lives of family members. They know that other children don't always enjoy the same things & are sensitive to this.
- They make observations of animals & plants & explain why some things occur, & talk about changes.
- They select and use technology for particular purposes.  
They use what they have learnt about media & materials in original ways and use a variety of materials, tools & techniques
